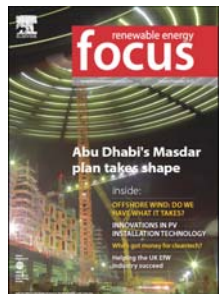
### ■ Membership Card

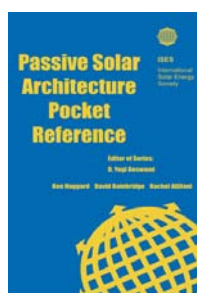


### ■ Electronic ISES Newsletter

### ■ Reduced prices at the ISES Online Shop

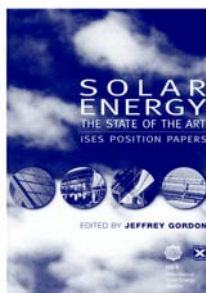
All publications presented in the ISES Online Shop accessible via ISES website are offered with at least 10% reduction on the normal book price. <http://shop.ises.org>
