

- Hosted in Bonn by WWEA






CONTEXT

- prepared by Global 100% RE members and supported by the German Environment Agency
- presented courses of action for local and regional governments, showcased municipalities and communities, and fostered dialogue with members of national government delegations





LOCAL DIMENSION OF THE NDCs


- Paris Agreement
- requiring every country to cooperate by doing "the most it can to help"
- Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs)
- Talanoa dialogue
- necessity for a shift towards renewable energy for effective climate action






INITIAL OUTCOMES

- local pioneers lead climate action
- local pioneers demonstrate that 100% renewable energy is not only possible but cost-effective
- collaboration between local and national governments is critical
- thus: NDCs have a strong local dimension that engages the national position on contributions



- tackle the currently observed lack of cross-level cooperation and coordination






BARRIERS AND CHALLENGES

- inflexibility






RECOMMENDATIONS

- facilitate communication with subnational stakeholders






POLICY ACTIONS FOR SUB-NATIONAL GOVERNMENTS

- enhance measures and policy tools that build on the economic case of renewables








